March 2020 also saw PNEUMA run our inaugural Campfire Youth event. We saw a gap in our denomination for exciting, energetic programs that bring young people together to socialise, grow in



their faith and feel part of a larger movement. We also wanted to help grow the capacity of some of our emerging young adult leaders.

We are pleased to report that the event was a resounding success. The program ran in Binningup over the March long weekend with 33 people in attendance. Of the seven leaders, four were young adults (aged between 17-20 years). The leaders came from Star St, Busselton and the Billabong congregations. They prepared and ran activities as well as leading worship and small group discussions. There were three formal sessions with input around what it means to live as a follower of Jesus.

The sense of fun and community over the course of the weekend was fantastic with a number of young people already asking when the next one is! We will be encouraging as many of them as possible to come (along with their families) to Campfire in Yealering later in the year and we plan to run another Campfire Youth at the same time and place in 2021.
